A stamped duplicate of the application for registration showing the date received by ADGA office will be accepted on animals less than six (6) months of age within **ONE** month of application. NO COPIES of the registration certificate will be accepted.

Owners having animals with open abscesses or ones close to breaking (hair missing) or any animal showing signs of pinkeye, soremouth, ringworm, or any other contagious disease will be asked to leave the fairgrounds. A vet will be on the premises for check-in.

Animals need to be vet checked before being put in pens.

THE DECISION OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE IS FINAL. BASE DATE FOR COMPUTING AGE IS May 21, 2016. EACH EXHIBITOR WILL BE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CONSEQUENCES OR OTHER LOSS, INJURY, OR OTHER DAMAGE DONE TO OR OCCASIONED BY OR ARISING FROM ANY ANIMAL EXHIBITED BY THEM OR ANY CHILD.
